The portions of Scripture that the students are required to learn for the month of April are listed below in bold. The Bible Club cut-off is **noon**, **Thursday**, **April 17**, **2025**. The previous month is listed underneath. All students in K-8 who recite their monthly scripture by this date will receive a Bible Club treat.

The KINDERGARTEN Scripture for April is:

Luke 8:16

Verse 16 No one lights a lamp and then covers it with a bowl or hides it under a bed. A lamp is placed on a stand where its light can be seen by all who enter the house.

The GRADES 1/2 Scripture for April is:

The GRADES 9-12 Scripture for April is:

Psalm 1:1-3

- Verse 2 But they delight in the law of the LORD, meditating on it day and night.
- Verse 3 They are like trees planted along the riverbank, bearing fruit each seasons. Their leaves never wither, and they prosper in all they do.

John 15:1-4 (NLT)

- Verse 1 I am the true grapevine, and my Father is the gardener.
- Verse 2 He cuts off every branch of mine that doesn't produce fruit, and he prunes the branches that do bear fruit so they will produce even more.
- Verse 3 You have already been pruned and purified by the message I have given you.
- Verse 4 Remain in me, and I will remain in you. For a branch cannot produce fruit if it is severed from the vine, and you cannot be fruitful unless you remain in me.
