The portions of Scripture that the students are required to learn for the month of March are listed below in bold. The Bible Club cut-off is **noon, Thursday, March 20, 2025**. The previous month is listed underneath. All students in K-8 who recite their monthly scripture by this date will receive a Bible Club treat.

The KINDERGARTEN Scripture for March is:

Luke 8:11 (NLT)

The GRADES 9-12 Scripture for March is:

John 15:1-4 (NLT)

- Verse 1 I am the true grapevine, and my Father is the gardener.
- Verse 2 He cuts off every branch of mine that doesn't produce fruit, and he prunes the branches that do bear fruit so they will produce even more.
- Verse 3 You have already been pruned and purified by the message I have given you.
- Verse 4 Remain in me, and I will remain in you. For a branch cannot produce fruit if it is severed from the vine, and you cannot be fruitful unless you remain in me.
